ye Majr togeather wth ye Majr part of ye Capta & Comission Officers of ye Severll Train bands on Rhode Island & ye Islands Adjacent under ye Majr Command as also in all Other matters of yt Nature as properly belonging unto them & it is further Enacted by ye authority aforesd yt ye majr & Commission officers on ye Main wthin this Iurisdiction have ye Like power & Authority as ye aforesd majr & Comission Officers of ye Island have in all Such cases as Aforesd any Act to ye Contrary notwithstanding This assembly Takeing Unto Considerations ye Frequent Misbehaveours Committed in this Iurisdiction towards his major officers in ye due & Lawfull Execution of their offices & ye former Laws in this Colony being very Short & not fully declareing wt Shall be Accounted Misbehavour

Be it Therefore Further Enacted by ye autthority aforesaid, That where ye Law of this Colony doth not fully declare w' Misbehauour is Towards his maj's officers in this Colony in ye due Execution of their se offices y' every person so Offending Shall be ludged by ye Laws of his maj's Realm of England in Each case made

### Att A Generall Assembly held for y Colony at Newport y 6th of may 1679

Be it Enacted by ye Goverer Councill & Representatives in This present Session Assembled & by ye authority of ye Same be it Enacted y' if any Person or Persons within this Iurisdiction Shall Imploy his Seruants or hire & Imploy any other mans

Servant or Seruants & Sett them to Labour on ye first day of ye week ye Person or Persons So offending Shall upon Proofe thereof made pay for every offence by him or them Comitted five Shilings in Mony to ye use of ye poor of ye Town or place in we're ye offence or offences are Comitted we're so five Shillings if ye person offending refuse upon Conuction before one Majestrates to pay, a warrant under ye hand of one majestrates directed to ye Serjant of the town where ye Offence was Comitted Shall be his Sufficient Warrant to take by distraint So much of ye Estate of ye offending Party togeather we're two Shilings for his Service therein

And be it Further Enacted by the authority aforesaid

That if any person or Persons Shall presume to sport game or play att any manner of game or games or Shooting out of any gun or Shall Sett tipling & drinking in any Tauern alehous Ordinary or Vitling house one ye first day of ye Week more then Necessety Requireth & Upon Examination of ye fact it Shall be ludged by any Iustice of ye Peace & ye Person or Persons so offending as aforesed Upon Conviction before one Iustice of Peace Shall by ye sed Iustice of ye Peace be Sentenced for every ye aforesed offences to Sett in ye Stocks three houres or pay five shillings in money for ye use of ye Poor of ye Town or place where ye Offences was Committed

And Whereas there hath been many Complaints by Masters of Ships & Other uessells to ye Authority in this Iurisdiction y' ye Seamen by them Shiped & retained, haue been Entertained by persons keeping Tauerns Alehouses Ordinarys or Uictualing houses to there great neglect & Hindrance in there Imployments & at ye time of there being Ready to Sail & put forth to Sea there men are by ye persons aforesed Attached Imprisoned & keept from their Lawfull Service to their great Loss & damage for Preuention of Which this Assembly Enacte

Declare y' if any Person or Persons y' Shall keep tauern alehouse Ordinary or Uictualling house within this Iurisdiction & Shall giue Credite Unto & trust any Seamen or Seaman y' Shall be Shiped & Ratained by any master of a Ship or other uessell without Order from ye Master of ye sd Ship or Uessell aboue ye Sum of sive Shilings no Action or Suit Shall Lye or be for ye Same

And be it Further Enacted by the authority aforesaid

That If any person or Persons Keeping all or any of ye houses aforesd Shall Presume to Arrest attach or Imprison any Seaman or Seamen Contrary to this Act he or they & every of them Shall be Liable to pay ye master of ye sd Sl.ip or other uessell ye damage or damages yt he or they Shall Sustain thereby who by himselfe or his Authority may have his action against any person or Persons So Offending for ye Same as in Action Debt

Att a Generall Assembly held for yt Colony att Newport yt 5th of May 1680

Bee it Enacted by ye Gover Councill & Representatives in this present Session Assembled & by ye authority of ye Same it is Enacted y' in all Actionall Cases brought to ye Generall Court of Tryalls if ye Plantiff or Desendant be agrieved after Iudgement Entred In Court upon review they may & have liberty to Make there Appeal to ye next Gener assembly for Relief provided Such appeal be made in ye Recorders Office ten days time After Iudgement Entred as aforesed as Also Such Person or Persons So appealing Shall first Pay Cost of Court & give in Bond as In case of Review & thereupon Execution Shall be Stoped till ye determination of ye assembly be Known

And it is further Enacted by ye authority aforesaid That ye person Appealing Shall Enter his reason of appeal tenn days before ye Court appealled Unto and the Defendant hath Liberty to take out ye Reasons of appeal & give in his answer at ye Court & that ye Plantiff take Coppys of ye Case from ye Recorder & Present ye whole Case to ye Court Appealled Unto paying ye Usual sees to ye Recorder ye he hath for Coppys at ye Gener!! Court of Tryalls & pay other sees according to ye Custom of o' Courts of Tryalls to ye Serjant for calling ye Case & no other sees to ye Recorder nor Serjant Except new Euidence be presented ye was not in ye former Courts

And Be it further Enacted be the Authority Aforesaid

That if ye Freemen inhabitants of any Town or village in this Colony do or Shall neglect to assemble togeather in Such former order as by Law or Custom they are bound or used to do & Chuse Such & So many officers as by Law or Custom they are to Chuse yt then it shall & may be Lawfull for ye Governer or Depty Gover wth six assists to Order appoint & Constitute under thei hands Such Officer or Officers in ye st Town Uilage or place as Shall to them Seem Meet for ye Carrying on the affaires depending & being between ye Colony & ye st Town Uilage or Place from time to time & also for ye Carrying on ye affair of ye st Town Uilage or Place any Law or Laws in this Colony to ye Contrary hereof in any wise notwithstanding [& for ye Regulating of all Disorderly Selling of all Sorts of Strong licquors Wine & Strong drink & setting up tipling houses without licence in any of ye Respective towns Uillages & Places of this Colony

Be it Enacted by ye Authority aforesaid

That ye Town Counsell of Each Respective town Vilage or Place or majr part of them on Legall Warnings & meeting are hear by authorized to grant Licences & to Suppress any Person that Shall Sell by Retail as aforesaid without or Contrar To there order & yt ye Offender or Offenders shall be liable to be dealt wth all According to ye Laws of England & Pay for ye first offence a fine of forty Shilings for their Transgression in or as money but in case ye Respective town Councills neglect then two Majestrates Upon Just Complaint

are authorized to give licence as well as to Suppress those y' disord 'ly Sell Drink as afores any law to y' Contrary hereof in any wife notwithstanding
