CHAPTER X.

An Act prohibiting the firing of guns and other fire arms in the City of New Haven.

CHAPTER XI.

An Act in addition to an Act entitled "An Act to amend the Charter of the City of Norwich," passed in May session, A. D. 1836.

Sec. 1.
