An ordinance regarding the carrying of concealed weapons and sale of deadly weapons, and repealing Sec. 117 of ordinance No. 102.

Be it ordained by the mayor and councilmen of the city of Concordia:

Sec. 1. On and after the passage of

Sec. 1. On and after the passage of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person within the city of Concordia

any person within the city of Concordia to carry upon his or her person any concealed pistol, bowie knife, dirk, sling shot, billy, knuckles or any other

deadly weapon, unless he has a permit to do so.

Sec. 2. That when it shall appear to the mayor that any person's employment or condition is such as to rend-

er it proper that he should carry a deadly weapon, he shall order the elerk to issue to such person a permit to carry a concealed weapon, which permit

shall be good for six months from the date of its issue, unless sooner revoked.

Sec. 3. That no such permit shall be issued until there be paid to the clerk the current or a dellar which shall be

the sum of one dollar, which shall be turned over to the city treasurer and credited to the general fund.

Sec. 4. The mayor may at any time

for cause revoke any such permit theretofore issued.

Sec. 5. Any person found guilty of violating Sec. one of this ordinance shall for the first offense be fined in any

sum not more than one hundred dollars, and for each subsequent offense not less than ten nor more than one hundred dollars.

Sec. 6. That section 117 of ordinance

No. 102 be, and is hereby, repealed. Sec. 7. That hereafter it shall be unlawful for any person within the city of Concordia to sell, loan or give to any

person under the age of 18 years any such pistol, bowie knife, sling shot, billy or knuckles or any other deadly weapon which can be concealed on the person. Sec. 8. Any person charged with
