SEC. 2. Such person and no others shall be termed "travelers" within the meaning of this ordinance as may be act-ually engaged in making a journey at the time.

Szc. 3. The Marshal may grant written permission to any person whose profes-tion or occupation may require him to be sut at late hours of the night, to carry concealed deadly weapons for his own protection.

The Marshal may at any time revoke any permit, and after notice to the per-son holding a permit and a demand for the return thereof, such permit shall im-mediately become void.

An ordinance to prohibit the carrying of concealed deadly weapons. The Common Council of the city of Marvaville do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, not being a public officer or

any person, not being a public officer of traveler, or not having a permit from the Marshal of the city of Marysville, to wear or carry concealed, or otherwise, within the limits of the city of Marysville, any pistol, dirk or other dangerous or SEC. 2. Such person and no others shall be termed "travelers" within the

meaning of this ordinance as may be actually engaged in making a journey at the time

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars or by imprisonment

not to exceed ten days, or by both. SEC. 3. The Marshal may grant written permission to any person whose profes-

aton or occupation may require him to be out at late hours of the night, to carry concealed deadly weapons for his own protection. The Marshal may at any time revoke

any permit, and after notice to the per-son holding a permit and a demand for the return thereof, such permit shall immediately become void. SEC. 4. The Marshal shall keep, or cause to be kept, a book in which shall be

recorded, the name of the person to whom a permit is granted. The date of such permit and the time the permit continues; the date when the permit is discontinued, and the date when the permit is revoked This ordinance shall take effect from

and after its passage and the same shall be published in the DAILY DENOCRAT, a newspaper published in the City of Marysville, for five days.
