### Ordinance No. 10.

An Ordinance Prohibiting the Carrying of  
Concealed Deadly Weapons, and Fixing  
the Penalty therefor.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Lompoc  
do Ordinances as follows:

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any  
person not being a public officer or traveler,  
not having a written permit from the President  
of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Lompoc,  
to wear or carry concealed, within  
the corporate limits of the Town of Lom-  
poc, any pistol, revolver, dirk, knife or other  
dangerous or deadly weapon.

Sec. 2. Every person violating any of the  
provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed  
guilty of a misdemeanor and be punished by  
a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars, or  
by imprisonment in the town jail, if there  
be one, and if not, then by imprisonment in  
the county jail of Santa Barbara County, for  
not exceeding thirty days, or by both such  
fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 3. Such persons, and no others, shall  
be termed "travelers" within the meaning  
of this Ordinance, as may be actually em-  
ployed in making a journey at the time.

Sec. 4. The President of the Board of  
Trustees of the Town of Lompoc may grant  
written permission to any person who  
whose profession or occupation may require  
him to be out after hours of the night within  
the corporate limits of the said Town of  
Lompoc, to carry concealed deadly weapons  
for his own protection.
