264 (13) Ordinance prohibiting the discharge
of Fire Arms within certain limits.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor &
Common Council of the City of San Jose,
Sec 1st No person shall discharge any fire
arms of any description whatever, in that
portion of the City included within Main St
& the Guadalupe river, and between Julian
& Williams Streets.

Any person violating this Ordinance
shall be fined not less than five dollars
nor more than thirty dollars for each
offence. And any person failing or
refusing to pay such fine as may be imposed
shall be imprisoned in the City prison not
exceeding ten days.

This Ordinance to take effect from &
after its approval by the Mayor.
